HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 699, L.D. 937, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Hunting by Nonresident Aliens."

Amend said Bill by inserting after the enacting clause,
the following:

"Sec. 1. R. S., T. 12, §1901, sub-§1, amended. Sub-
section 1 of section 1901 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes
is amended to read as follows:

'1. Aliens. All aliens shall be classified as non-
residents. Any alien who has resided in this State continuously
for one year and in addition thereto is assessed and pays
taxes on real estate in the municipality in which he resides
or any alien who has resided in this State continuously for
5 years may purchase any resident license issued under chapters
301 to 335.'"

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning
of the first line the underlined abbreviation and figure
'Sec. 2.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the
underlined 5th, 6th and 7th lines and inserting in place
thereof the following:

"hunting, by a resident guide, licensed under chapter 307,
who may guide no more than 3 of such nonresident aliens at
any one time, and this sentence shall apply only to the
Northern and Central Zones.'"
