HOUSE AMENDMENT "D" to H.P. 699, L.D. 937, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Hunting by Nonresident Aliens."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the
enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

"R. S., T. 12, §1901, sub-§1, amended. Subsection 1
of section 1901 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended
to read as follows:

'1.- Aliéns. All aliens shall be classified as non-
residents. Any alien who has resided in this State contin-
uously for one year and in addition thereto is assessed and
pays taxes on real estate in the municipality in which he
resides or any alien who has resided in this State contin-
uously for 5 years may purchase any resident license issued
under chapters 301 to 335.'" "
