SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 699, L. D. 937, Bill, "An Act Relating  
to Hunting by Nonresident Aliens."

Amend said Bill in the Title by adding before the period the  
following: 'and Certain Complimentary Licenses'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the  
first line the underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec.1.'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end the following:

"Sec. 2. R. S., T. 12, §2601, sub-§11-A, additional. Section  
2601 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new  
subsection 11-A, to read as follows:

'11-A. Complimentary licenses to persons over 70 years of age.  
A complementary license to fish shall be issued to any resident of  
Maine who is over 70 years of age and applies therefor.' "
