STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Hunting by Nonresident Aliens.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2401, sub-§ 4, amended. Subsection 4 of section 2401 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read as follows:

'A nonresident alien must be accompanied, at all times while hunting, by a regular Maine guide, licensed under chapter 307, who may guide no more than 6 of such nonresidents at any one time.'
