STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Hearings for Permits for Contract Carriers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 35, § 1555, sub-§ 3, amended. The next to the last sentence of subsection 3 of section 1555 of Title 35 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Contract carriers now operating by virtue of so-called grandfather rights granted by the commission pursuant to this subsection as originally enacted, and whose present permits, in the opinion of the commission, need clarification, may be directed, upon reasonable notice given as provided, to appear before the commission for further public hearing, at which hearing evidence of regular operation as a contract carrier from March I, 1932 to June 30, 1933 may be submitted, and the carrier may supplement same by also submit evidence of regular any additional operation developed from industrial or business demand for transportation service subsequent to said period, and the original and new evidence presented.'
