IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Providing Funds to Create a Division of Indian Affairs within the Department of Health and Welfare.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Division of Indian Affairs; appropriation for. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Welfare the sum of \$21,160 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1966 and \$21,460 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1967, for the purpose of implementing the provision of section 4702 of Title 22 of the Revised Statutes to create within the Department of Health and Welfare a Division of Indian Affairs. The breakdown shall be as follows:
