AN ACT Appropriating Moneys for Construction of a Reception Diagnostic Treatment Center for Persons Committed to any Penal Institution.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$975,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1966 to the Department of Mental Health and Corrections to construct a reception diagnostic treatment center for persons committed to any penal institution under the supervision of the department. This shall be a continuing carrying account until the purposes of this Act have been accomplished.
