**AN ACT Relating to Appointment of Chairmen of Boards of Registration in
Cities of Certain Population.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 21, § 43, amended. The first paragraph of section 43 of Title 21 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

‘In a city which has a population of 5,000 ~~or over~~ and under 25,000, a board of registration consisting of 3 members must be appointed as follows: One member nominated by the city committees of each of the 2 major parties and appointed by the municipal officers, and the 3rd member appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Council.’

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 21, § 44, additional. Title 21 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 44, to read as follows:

‘§ 44. Board of registration in cities of 25,000 and over

In a city which has a population of 25,000 or over, a board of registration shall be appointed as provided in section 43, except that the 3rd member shall be appointed by the municipal officers and shall be chairman. All other provisions of section 43 shall apply to this section.’
