**AN ACT Relating to Driving Motor Vehicle Under Influence of Combination
of Drugs and Liquor.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 29, § 1312, amended. The first sentence of section 1312 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

‘Whoever shall operate or attempt to operate a motor vehicle upon any way, or in any other place when intoxicated or at all under the influence of intoxicating liquor or drugs, **or a combination of both**, upon conviction, shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$100 nor more than \$1,000, or by imprisonment for not less than 10 days nor more than 11 months, or by both.’
