AN ACT Relating to Time of Abolition of Urban Renewal Authorities.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 4803, sub-§ 2-A, additional. Section 4803 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new subsection 2-A to read as follows:

'2-A. Abolition of Urban Renewal Authority. An Urban Renewal Authority shall be automatically abolished 6 months from the date on which the municipal officers disapprove an urban renewal plan, unless within that time the plan has been resubmitted and accepted by the municipal officers, or unless the authority is carrying out a different urban renewal plan previously accepted. An Urban Renewal Authority shall be automatically abolished on the date on which the voters of a municipality disapprove a proposed urban renewal plan, unless the authority is carrying out a different urban renewal plan previously approved.'
