HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 747, L.D. 984, Bill, "An Act Relating to Approval of Urban Renewal Plans."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the amending clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

" 'On the written petition of a number of voters equal to 10% or more of the total votes cast for Governor in the municipality at the last election at which a Governor was elected filed with the clerk of the municipality within 30 days after approval of the final plan for urban renewal by the municipal officers, a referendum vote shall be held in the municipality. The form of the question shall be: "Shall the final urban renewal plan approved by the municipal officers on (date plan approved by municipal officers) be accepted?" The referendum shall be held within 30 days from the date on which the petition is filed with the clerk. The referendum shall be called and held in the manner prescribed for calling and holding town meetings or elections in the municipality. The voters shall indicate by a cross or check mark placed within a square upon their ballots their opinion, those in favor of the approved plan voting "Yes" and those opposed to the approved plan voting "No." If a majority of those voting are in favor of the approved plan, it shall be declared by the municipal officers to be accepted.' "
