AN ACT Relating to Approval of Urban Renewal Plans.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 4806, sub-§ 7, amended. Subsection 7 of section 4806 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new paragraph to read as follows:

‘On the written petition of a number of voters equal to at least 10% of the number of votes cast for Governor in the municipality at the last gubernatorial election filed with the clerk of the municipality within 30 days after approval of the renewal plan by the municipal officers, the following question shall be submitted to a referendum vote of all the voters of the municipality: “Shall the urban renewal plan approved by the municipal officers on (date plan approved by municipal officers) be also approved by the voters of (name of municipality)?” The referendum shall be held within 30 days from the date on which the petition is filed with the clerk. If the majority of ballots cast is in the negative, an urban renewal plan which includes any of the area covered by the rejected plan may not be proposed for at least 5 years from the date of the referendum.’
