# STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

#### AN ACT Relating to Certain Liquor Licensees Providing Entertainment to Charge Admission.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 28, § 702, amended.** The last paragraph of section 702 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Licensed hotels and restaurants malt liquor licensees who have been issued such special amusement permit may charge admission in designated areas approved by the commission.'
