**AN ACT Relating to Certain Liquor Licensees Providing Entertainment to
Charge Admission.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 28, § 702, amended. The last paragraph of section 702 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Licensed hotels and restaurants malt liquor licensees who have been issued such special amusement permit may charge admission **in designated areas approved by the commission.**'
