STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Liquor Fees of Hotels Serving and Not Serving Meals.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 28, § 701, amended. The first paragraph of section 701 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Fees for full-year licenses shall be:

Hotel—Spirituous and vinous serving meals, in cities or towns having population of 10,000 or more \$600.00
Hotel—Spirituous and vinous, not serving meals, in cities or towns having popu- lation of 10,000 or more
Hotel—Spirituous and vinous serving meals, in cities or towns having population of less than 10,000
Hotel—Spirituous and vinous, not serving meals, in cities or towns having popu- lation of less than 10,000
