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AN ACT Relating to Liquor Fees of Hotels Serving and Not Serving Meals.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 28, § 701, amended.** The first paragraph of section 701 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

‘Fees for full-year licenses shall be:

Hotel—Spirituous and vinous <b>serv</b> ing meals, in cities or towns having population of 10,000 or more .....	\$600.00
<b>Hotel—Spirituous and vinous, not serv</b> ing meals, in cities or towns having population of 10,000 or more .....	1,000.00
Hotel—Spirituous and vinous <b>serv</b> ing meals, in cities or towns having population of less than 10,000 .....	300.00
<b>Hotel—Spirituous and vinous, not serv</b> ing meals, in cities or towns having population of less than 10,000 .....	500.00’
