AN ACT Relating to Definition of Premise Under Liquor Laws.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 28, § 2, sub-§ 16, amended. Subsection 16 of section 2 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end the following new sentence:

'Nothing herein shall require that any licensed premises of a licensee be completely separated from areas or premises which are not licensed or are licensed to another licensee, provided only that the access to and from any adjoining premises shall be subject to such reasonable regulations as the commission may adopt.'
