STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Regulating Liquor Salesmen.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 28, § 901, amended. Section 901 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end a new sentence to read as follows:

'No salesman shall be a Member of the Legislature of the State of Maine.'
