**AN ACT Relating to Rules and Regulations for Safety and Welfare of Railroad
Employees.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 35, § 1198, additional. Title 35 of the Revised Statutes is amended by
adding a new section 1198 to read as follows:

‘§ 1198. **Safety, sanitation and adequate shelter**

The Public Utilities Commission is authorized to promulgate and enforce
reasonable rules and regulations relating to safety, sanitation and adequate
shelter as they affect the welfare and health of railroad employees.’
