SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 758, L. D. 995, Bill, "An Act  
Relating to Rules Regarding Retirement of Teachers."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the Title and inserting  
in place thereof the following:

'AN ACT Providing for Compulsory Retirement of Teachers.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out everything after the  
enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

"R. S., T. 5, §1121, sub-§1, Par. D, additional. Subsection 1  
of section 1121 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes is amended by  
adding a new paragraph D to read as follows:

'D. Commencing July 1, 1965 any teacher shall be retired who  
attains age 70, reduced by one year of age for each one-year  
period thereafter, until the compulsory retirement age becomes  
age 65. At the end of a school year all teachers who have then  
attained the compulsory retirement age shall be retired forthwith,  
provided that upon the recommendation of the superintendent of  
schools the member may be granted an extension in service year by  
year by the State Board of Education, but in no case beyond the  
end of the school year during which he attains age 70.'
