SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to H. P. 758, L. D. 995, Bill, "An Act Relating to Rules Regarding Retirement of Teachers."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the Title and inserting in place thereof the following:

'AN ACT Providing for Retirement of Teachers.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

"R. S., T. 5, §1121, sub-~~§1~~, ¶D, additional. Subsection 1 of section 1121 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new paragraph D to read as follows:

'D. At the end of a school year all teachers who have attained age 65 shall be retired forthwith, provided that upon the recommendation of the superintendent of schools and the school board the member may be granted an extension in service year by year by the State Board of Education, but in no case beyond the end of the school year during which he attains age 70. Any teacher who is refused such recommendation may appeal such decision to the State Board of Education for final disposition. This paragraph shall not apply to teachers who were born prior to January 1, 1910 and who are, on the effective date of this Act, currently teaching in Maine.'"
