AN ACT Relating to Rules Regarding Retirement of Teachers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 20, § 473, sub-§ 11, additional. Section 473 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new subsection 11 to read as follows:

'11. Rules regarding retirement of teachers. They shall make such rules regarding the retirement of teachers as they deem expedient, except that they may not fix a uniform retirement age below 65.'
