COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 760, L. D. 997, Bill,
"An Act Repealing Property Tax Exemption for Pleasure Boats in
the State for Storage or Repair."

Amend said Bill in the Title by striking out the word
"Repealing" and inserting in place thereof the words 'Relating to'

Further amend said Bill by striking out everything after
the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

"R. S., T. 36, §655, sub-§1, H, amended. Paragraph H
of subsection 1 of section 655 of Title 36 of the Revised Statutes
is amended to read as follows:

'H. Pleasure vessels and boats in the State on the first
day of each April whose owners reside out of the State, and
which are left-in-this-State-temporarily-by-the-owners-for
the-purposes-of-repair-or-storage-and-for-a-consideration
brought into this State specifically for the purposes of
repair or storage.' "
