STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Repealing Property Tax Exemption for Pleasure Boats in the State for Storage or Repair.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., T. 36, § 655, sub-§ 1, ¶ H, repealed. Paragraph H of subsection 1 of section 655 of Title 36 of the Revised Statutes is repealed, as follows:
 - 'H. Pleasure vessels and boats in the State on the first day of each April whose owners reside out of the State, and which are left in this State temporarily by the owners for the purposes of repair or storage and for a consideration.'
