AN ACT Relating to Property of Agricultural Societies Taken by Eminent Domain.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 7, § 61, amended. Section 61 of Title 7 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new paragraph to read as follows:

'The real estate owned by county and local agricultural societies shall not be subject to taking by eminent domain proceedings for school purposes by School Administrative Districts or other school authorities.'

Sec. 2. Application. Any eminent domain proceedings already instituted against the property of agricultural societies, contrary to this Act, are hereby declared to be vacated, null and void.
