STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Reestablishing Western Maine Sanatorium in Hebron as a Nursing Home for the Elderly.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Western Maine Sanatorium reestablished. Western Maine Sanatorium, located at Hebron and discontinued as a sanatorium by the 99th Legislature, is reestablished as a nursing home for the elderly.
- Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Welfare to carry out the purposes of this Act the sum of \$440,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1966 and the sum of \$440,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1967; the breakdown of which shall be as follows:
