STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Sale or Compounding of Drugs by Apothecary Only.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 32, § 2801, amended. Section 2801 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read as follows:

'No person, except a registered apothecary or a registered assistant pharmacist, shall personally sell drugs, compound physician's prescriptions or prepared pharmaceutical preparations.'
