AN ACT Relating to Municipal Regulation of Community Antennae Television Systems.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 2151, sub-§ 2, ¶ G, additional. Subsection 2 of section 2151 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new paragraph G, to read as follows:

'G. To authorize its municipal officers to contract on such terms and conditions, and impose such fees, as are in the best interests of the municipality, for the placing and maintenance of community antennae television systems and appurtenances along public ways. Revenues received from such contracts shall be credited to general funds. Systems located in accordance with such ordinances and contracts are not defects in public ways.'
