IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Testimony in Tort Actions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 16, § 1, amended. The first paragraph of section 1 of Title 16 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Sections 53, 54, 154, 201 and 557 do not apply in tort actions or to cases where, at the time of taking testimony or at the time of trial, the party prosecuting or the party defending, or any one of them, is an executor or an administrator or is made a party as heir of a deceased party; except in the following cases:'
