STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Procedure of Applying to Form a School Administrative District.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 20, § 215, sub-§ 1, amended. Subsection 1 of section 215 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end the following:

'The voters of a municipality may at a duly called special or regular town meeting or city election instruct the school committee to file an application with the board setting forth the names of the municipalities that propose to join to form said district. The article to be inserted in the warrant shall be in the following form: To see if the municipality will vote to instruct its superintending school committee to file an application with the State Board of Education for the purpose of forming a School Administrative District with the following towns, naming them. The school committee shall file applications on a form to be prepared by the board and shall furnish such other data as the board may determine necessary and proper for its deliberations.'
