AN ACT Relating to Notice to Utilities in Discontinuing Town and County Roads.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 23, § 2052, amended. Section 2052 of Title 23 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding before the last sentence a new sentence to read as follows:

'In the case of discontinuance, said notice shall also be served on any public utility or sewer district having facilities located in said portion to be discontinued.'

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 23, § 3004, amended. The first sentence of section 3004 of Title 23 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'A town, at a meeting called by warrant containing an article for the purpose, may discontinue a town or private way, provided that notice of said article is mailed by the municipal officers, on or prior to the date of the posting of said warrant, to any public utility or sewer district having facilities located in said portion to be discontinued.'
