STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Increasing Salaries of Members of Liquor Commission.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 28, § 53, amended. The first sentence of section 53 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'The salary of the chairman of the commission (Liquor) shall be \$2,500 \$12,500 per year and the salary of each of the other members shall be \$5,625 \$7,500 per year, and in addition each member shall be allowed his reasonable expense incurred in the performance of his duties.'
