STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Increasing Salary of Reporter of Decisions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 4, § 701, amended. Section 701 of Title 4 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'§ 701. Appointment and tenure; salary

The Governor with the advice and consent of the Council shall, in case of a vacancy, appoint a person learned in the law to be Reporter of the Decisions of the law court, who shall hold his office during the pleasure of the executive. He shall receive an annual salary of \$2,500 \$3,700.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$900 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1966 and the sum of \$1,200 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1967 to carry out the purposes of this Act.
