**AN ACT Relating to Time of Payments of Benefits Under Employment Security
Law.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 26, § 1192-A, additional. Title 26 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 1192-A, to read as follows:

‘§ 1192-A. Time of payment of benefits

Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter, benefits shall be paid at the same time when the claim for benefits has been made. It is the intent of the Legislature that there shall be no lapse of time between the time of making a claim for benefits and the time of paying such benefits.’
