AN ACT Relating to Election of Officers of Independent Churches.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 13, § 3024, amended. Section 3024 of Title 13 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

§ 3024. Election of officers

The resident members shall, by ballot, elect a clerk, treasurer, a business committee of not less than 3 ~~not more than 7~~ members who are voters and such other officers as they may deem necessary.'
