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**AN ACT Permitting Livermore Falls Water District to Take Water from Certain  
Sources.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**P. & S. L., 1907, c. 390, § 2, amended.** Section 2 of chapter 390 of the private and special laws of 1907 is amended to read as follows:

'**Sec. 2. Taking of waters from certain ponds, etc.** The said district, for the purpose of its incorporation, is hereby authorized to take, hold, divert, use and distribute water from Moose Hill Pond, so-called, in said East Livermore and from the North Livermore Ponds, so-called, situated in the Town of Livermore, and from Parker Pond situated in the Town of Jay, County of Franklin, and from any lake, pond, stream, brook, river or similar water course or from any well, spring or similar ground water supply located within the area authorized to be served by the said district.'
