AN ACT Relating to Payment by Dealers to Producers for Milk Purchased.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 7, § 2954-A, additional. Title 7 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 2954-A, to read as follows:

‘§ 2954-A. Payment by dealers to producers

At least as often as every 60 days, each dealer shall make payment to his producers of all sums due for products purchased or received during the preceding 60-day period.

Upon due notice and after hearing, the Maine Milk Commission may suspend or revoke the license of a dealer who violates this section.’
