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AN ACT Providing for State Contributions to Industrial Pollution Abatement.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Sec. 1. R. S., T. 38, § 412-A, additional.** Title 38 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 412-A, to read as follows:

**§ 412-A. State contribution to industrial pollution abatement**

The Water Improvement Commission is authorized to contribute from state, and federal funds if available, up to  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the cost of construction of industrial waste treatment plants for existing and new industries. Not exceeding \$250,000 shall be contributed for any one project.'

**Sec. 2. Appropriation.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Water Improvement Commission the sum of \$1,000,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1966 to carry out the purposes of this Act, and any portion thereof not used shall not lapse but shall be carried forward as a permanent fund for such purposes.
