## STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

#### AN ACT Relating to Election of Clerks and Secretaries of Trust Companies.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 9, § 1041, amended. Section 1041 of Title 9 of the Revised Statutes is amended by inserting after the 7th sentence a new sentence to read as follows:

'The stockholders shall elect a clerk at the first meeting held by the incorporators and at each annual meeting thereafter, who shall be sworn to the proper discharge of his duties and hold office until his successor is elected and qualified.'

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 9, § 1041, amended. The 3rd sentence from the end of section 1041 of Title 9 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'The board of directors shall elect a president from its number, a elect who shall be sworn to the faithful performance of his duties secretary, a treasurer and such other officers as they may deem necessary, who shall be sworn to the faithful performance of their duties.'
