IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Status of Academies, Seminaries and Institutes as Public High Schools for Certain Purposes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 20, § 1281, amended. Section 1281 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end the following new sentence:

‘When an academy, seminary or institute has received basic approval as in this section provided and has entered into a contract with one or more administrative units for the education of all or part of its pupils in the curriculum contemplated by this section and has received at least 50% of all the pupils of any such unit under such contract, it shall have the same status as a public high school for the purpose of, and shall be eligible to receive and participate in, all federal and state subsidies and programs should it so desire.’
