# STATE OF MAINE

#### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

#### AN ACT Relating to Definition of Dependent Children.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. I. R. S., T. 22, § 3741, sub-§§ I and 2, amended. Subsections I and 2 of section 3741 of Title 22 of the Revised Statutes are amended to read as follows:

'I. Aid to dependent children. The term "aid to dependent children" means money payments with respect to, or medical care in behalf of or any type of remedial care in behalf of, a dependent child or dependent children, and includes money payments or medical care or any type of remedial care for any month to meet the needs of the relative with whom any dependent child is living if money payments have been made with respect to such child for such month, and if the relative with whom such dependent child is living is the parent of said child, the needs of the spouse of such parent may be included in accordance with Title IV of the Social Security Act, as amended except as said Title applies to unemployment.

2. Dependent child. The term "dependent child," wherever used in this chapter, shall be construed to mean a needy child under the age of 18 who has been deprived of parental support or care by reason of the death, continued absence from home or the physical or mental incapacity or unemployment, as defined by the department, of a parent and who is living with his father, mother, grandfather, grandmother, brother, sister, stepfather, stepmother, stepbrother, stepsister, uncle, aunt, first cousin, nephew or niece in a place of residence maintained by one or more of such relative as his or their own home.'

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to

the Department of Health and Welfare the sum of \$137,060 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1966 and the sum of \$169,490 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1967 to carry out the purposes of this Act. The breakdown shall be as follows:
