AN ACT Increasing Retirement Allowances of State Employees Retired on Council Orders.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 5, § 1121, sub-§ 2, ¶ G, additional. Subsection 2 of section 1121 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new paragraph G, to read as follows :

'G. Those state employees who retired on council orders shall have their monthly retirement allowances increased by $\frac{1}{2}$ of the present amount they are now receiving, except those cases which have been increased by special resolve.'

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$9,200 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1966 and the sum of \$9,200 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1967 to carry out the purposes of this Act.

Sec. 3. Effective date. The increase provided under this Act shall become effective on the first day of the month following the effective date of this Act.
