COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 335, L. D. 1080, Bill, "An Act  
Relating to Tuition for Students Attending Secondary  
School Outside of Residence."

Amend said Bill, in section 2, by striking out in the 20th  
line from the end the underlined words "from bond issues"

Further amend said Bill, in section 2, by inserting after  
the underlined words "schools of the State" in the 13th line from  
the end, the following: ',except that any unit which receives state  
or federal funds for capital outlay purposes, either equipment or  
construction, shall have such amounts deducted from the allowable  
insured value of buildings and equipment in the tuition computation'
