HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 335, L. D. 1080, Bill,
"An Act Relating to Tuition for Students Attending Secondary
School Outside of Residence."

Amend said Bill, in the 4th sentence from the end, by
striking out the underlined words "from bond issues"

Further amend said Bill by inserting after the 3rd
sentence from the end the following:

'Any unit which receives state or federal funds as school
construction aid under Title 20, section 3518, shall have
such amounts deducted from the allowable insured value of
buildings and equipment in the tuition computation.'
