AN ACT Relating to Bringing Contraband Articles Within the State Prison.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 34, § 755, repealed and replaced. Section 755 of Title 34 of the Revised Statutes is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

§ 755. Contraband articles brought within prison

Any person who brings or attempts to bring into the prison any article of contraband shall be conclusively presumed to have intended to deliver such article to a prisoner, and shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$1,000 or by imprisonment for not more than 2 years. "Contraband" for the purpose of this section is defined as any article not allowed by the Warden of the State Prison for general usage by any or all prisoners within the prison.'
