AN ACT Relating to Trapping Beaver.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2360, amended. The last paragraph of section 2360 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'No person, except as otherwise provided, shall molest or destroy any beaver dam or set or tend any trap within 10 feet of the same. No person shall molest or destroy any beaver house or set any trap within 25 feet of the same. **No person shall set or tend any beaver trap within 4 feet of a beaver trap which has been set by another trapper.**'
