AN ACT Relating to Shooting Animals in Roadside Menageries.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 1904, amended. Section 1904 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end, a new paragraph, to read as follows:

'Whoever kills any animal kept in a roadside menagerie under this section shall be liable to the owner thereof in an amount equal to 3 times the value of the animal killed and shall be punished by a fine of \$200 or by imprisonment for 30 days, or by both.'
