# STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

#### AN ACT Relating to Proximity of State Liquor Stores to Recreation Buildings and Playgrounds.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 28, § 152, amended.** Section 152 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

#### '§ 152. Proximity to churches, schools and recreational areas

No such store shall be established within 300 feet of any public or private school, **public recreational building**, **public playground**, church, chapel or parish house, measured from the main entrance of the state store to the main entrance of the school, **public recreation building**, **public playground**, church, chapel or parish house by the ordinary course of travel.'
