AN ACT Requiring Permits to Dam Waters for Recreational Purposes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2203, amended. Section 2203 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end, a new paragraph, to read as follows:

‘A person, political subdivision, firm or corporation must apply for and receive a written permit from the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game before constructing, repairing, rebuilding or altering a dam, the purpose of which is to create an impoundment for use in part or wholly for recreational purposes.’
