STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Lights Used on Motor Vehicles Operated by State Liquor Inspectors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., T. 29, § 1368, sub-§ 2, amended. Subsection 2 of section 1368 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:
- '2. Police department vehicles. Lights used on police department vehicles and on motor vehicles operated by chiefs of police, state fire inspectors, inland fisheries and game wardens, sea and shore fisheries wardens, state liquor inspectors and the chief thereof, sheriffs and deputy sheriffs shall emit a blue beam of light.'
